# STEP 5

Position the second circle on top of the first one and align them as closely as possible. Allow the glue to set before continuing - see fig. 3.

# STEP 6

Mark the circle at the points shown in fig. 4. Drill each point straight through on both circles using 1.3cm bit.

# STEP 7

Take one of the Metal Rods (3) & fix to one of the circles as shown in fig. 5 at the top of the circle.

# STEP 8

Repeat Step 7 for the other points on the circle except for the two with the feet attached at the ends.

# STEP 9

At one of the circle Feet fix a Metal Rod as shown in fig. 6 at the foot of the page.

### STEP 10

Repeat Step 9 for the other end of the circle.

# STEP 11

Fix the second circle to the first circle as shown in fig. 7.

# STEP 12

Fix the Brackets (f) to the Feet as in **Step 9** - see *fig.6*.

# STEP 13

Position the circle and fix the Brackets securely.

# STEP 14

Carry out a final check of the Bolts for tightness.


